WHITE STAR LINE BRASS CUFF LINKS

In 1902, when J. Pierpont Morgan's International Mercantile Marine Company (IMMCO) added the White Star Line to his list of shipping companies, American businesses as well as their British counterparts were sought in order to have suppliers on both sides of the Atlantic. The Waterbury Button Company was chosen to make the brass buttons for White Star Line officers' uniforms. These regulation size White Star Line brass buttons are made to the exacting standards required by a company known for quality metal buttons that are made for the US Armed Forces, airlines, steamship companies including the White Star Line.

When the TITANIC movie was made, the production company asked if the company still had the original stamp tools that made the White Star buttons. They did. The Waterbury Button Company made the buttons that were wore by actors for the film. **As part of the movie premiere, the company was asked to make cuff links to be given out at the after parties as gifts.**

A number of these unique gift sets of White Star Line brass cuff links were just found in their warehouse.
